Job Function/Summary

Responsible for feeding, cleaning and caring for all shelter animals. Maintains the cleanliness and orderliness of the facility and grounds.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

- Complete daily cleaning routines, maintaining assigned area in a clean, organized and professional manner. Provide kennel enrichment, train, and socialize animals in assigned area as time permits.
- Learn and adhere to SHS guidelines, policies, procedures and protocol
- Monitor the health of shelter animals; follow established procedures if symptoms of illness arise based on the degree of illness or injury.
- Monitor animals' temperament/behavior looking for food aggression, dog aggression and any other changed negative behavior.
- Ensures dogs receive daily exercise.
- General housekeeping including but not limited to lobby, restrooms, break room and laundry.
- Outside maintenance: keeps grounds clear of trash and animal waste, sweeps/cleans sidewalks and drives including back area.
- Communicate effectively and professionally with co-workers, management and the public at all times.
- Promote positive relationships with the general public, volunteers and staff while promoting our programs, policies and philosophies.
- Grooms and bathes dogs and cats.
- Treats all animals humanely, properly and with compassion at all times, regardless of the situation or circumstance.

- SHS is open seven days a week including holidays. Kennel Staff is required to work most weekends and all holidays.
