Shelby Humane Society Receives \$60,000 Grant from PetSmart Charities®

Columbiana, AL—Shelby Humane Society announced today that it has received a \$60,000 grant from PetSmart Charities – the leading funder of animal welfare in North America. This grant will provide subsidized spay and neuter surgeries for cats and dogs owned by residents of Shelby County who live in zip codes 35147, 35137, 35114, and 35176.

"This grant offers financial support to responsible pet owners who are trying to do what's best," says Cassidy Sklar, Grants Coordinator. "We expect to help to spay or neuter at least 800 cats and dogs, which is made possible through a generous grant from PetSmart Charities."

PetSmart Charities aims to proactively prevent pet homelessness through many efforts including adoption and increased spay and neuter efforts. With the help of animal welfare partners, including Shelby Humane Society, PetSmart Charities has funded over 1.4 million spay and neuter surgeries in the U.S. since 2009.

The Shelby Humane Society will administer the \$60,000 grant through its Quick Fix Program, which already offers low-cost spay and neuter surgeries to Shelby County residents. "We typically have fewer surgeries scheduled through our Quick Fix Program from these four areas of Shelby County," says Allyssa Colburn, Quick Fix Coordinator for SHS. "In offering this special opportunity, we hope to increase the quality of life for these animals while having a significant impact on the dog and cat overpopulation problem. This will definitely be good news for families that own pets in these communities!" Since the Quick Fix Program started in 2008, Shelby Humane Society has seen a significant decrease in intake numbers each and every year.

A portion of the grant will also be used to support education and marketing efforts including billboards, yard signs, local newspaper ads, and presentations to community groups.
