



Shelby Humane Meet-and-Greet Guidelines

- Your resident pet is not allowed to walk through our kennel area with you. If you do not already have a specific pet you are interested in, you will need to bring a friend or family member with you to wait with your pet while you walk through our adoption area. **Adoption staff cannot be responsible for your pet while you walk through our adoption area.**
- The employees who facilitate meet-and-greets are trained professionals with experience specific to shelter animals. **Please listen to and follow our employee's instructions.**
- Please do not allow nose-to-nose interactions between the dogs.
- Only the people handling the dogs should be in the immediate area when the meet-and-greet begins. We ask that children not be in the area during the meet-and-greet.
- Please do not stand between the dogs, or try to force any unwanted interactions between them.
- Shelby Humane Society leashes must be used on all dogs involved in a meet-and-greet, unless otherwise approved by an SHS employee. **We ask that no retractable leashes be used during a meet-and-greet.**
- Off-leash meet-and-greets are only to be performed at the discretion of Shelby Humane employees; this is not common to do in this environment.
- Shelby Humane Society employees have the authority to end a meet-and-greet at any time, and for any reason.
- All people present for the meet-and-greet must read and understand these rules.

- **Wednesday-Friday:** 12p-1p | 1p-2p | 2p-3p | 3p-4p
- **Saturdays:** 1p-2p | 2p-3p
